<b>Course Name</b>	<b>JUVENILE FIRESETTER INTERVENTION SPECIALIST I</b>
<b>Course Code</b>	<b>FP204</b>
<b>Course Length</b>	16 Hours
<b>Course Description</b>	This course provides the student with the skills and tools necessary to become a Juvenile Fire setter Intervention Specialist 1. The class will address the NFPA 1035, Juvenile Fire setter Intervention Specialist 1, including introduction, primary prevention, identification and intake, who sets fires and why, and interviewing and intervention strategies. The students will be introduced to the NFPA 1034, Juvenile Fire setter Intervention Specialist I Professional Standard and will learn to conduct an interview with fire setters and their families using prepared forms and guidelines. Based on recommended practice, students may determine the need for referral for counseling and/or implement educational intervention strategies to mitigate effects of fire setting behavior.
<b>Course Materials</b>	Pen, Pencil, Highlighter, Paper
<b>Special Note:</b>	Target Audience: Individuals that have responsibilities related to Juvenile Fire setting Intervention, interviewing, and prevention. The target audience includes practitioners who interact with children who are involved in fire setting and/or arson behavior and their families. In addition to the fire service, professionals from a myriad of fields including Mental Health, Law Enforcement, Education, Counseling Services, and Social Services can benefit from the training.

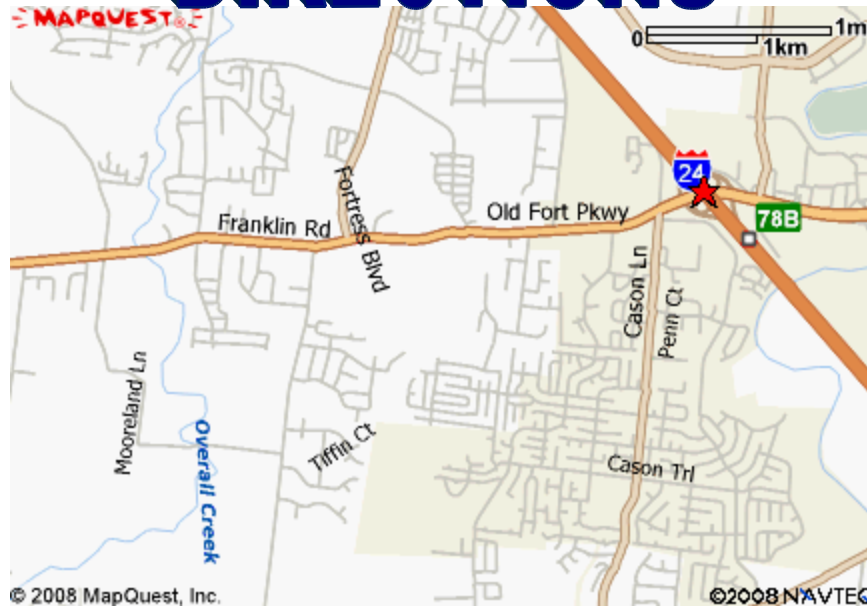
